Crestview College Preparatory School's mission is to prepare graduates for post-secondary education, while instilling in them a responsibility for their community.

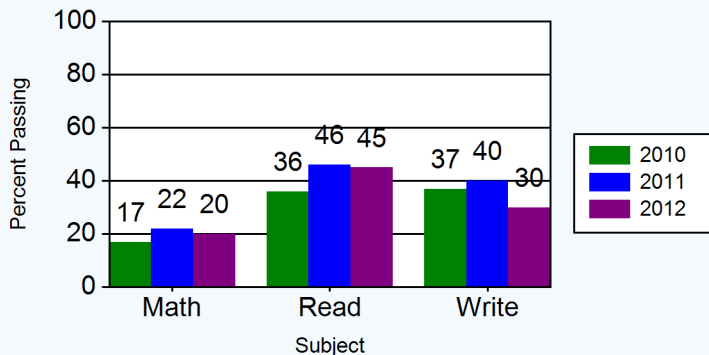
Vision

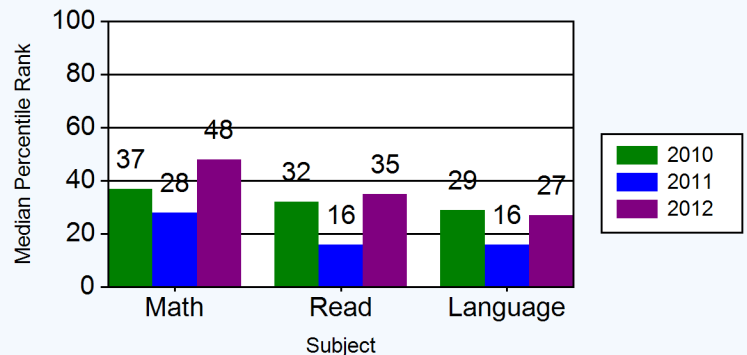
